Ecuador constitutes one of the most important hotspots of biodiversity worldwide. Due to agrarian colonisation, cattle ranching, mining, timber logging and other deforestation activities, biodiversity loss is immense and it is estimated that after 2050 there will be no primary forest outside of conservation areas anymore. To combat the worldwide biodiversity crisis along with the deforestation of tropical forests/ rainforests a web-based higher education course about biodiversity conservation and governance within UNESCO's Biosphere Reserves will be developed together with FLACSO students from Quito, Ecuador and presented during a winter school in February/ March 2022.
